

Topic: Ft Hood Natural & Cultural Resources – Prescribed Fire strategies: minimize potential harm to endangered species, decrease vegetative fuels loads to reduce the risk of wildfires, limit the encroachment of junipers (cedar) and other types of woody vegetation into healthy grasslands, and provide open space for military training. Many scientific tests are conducted to determine the fitness of those working in the field as well as the testing for soil moisture deficit (KBDI) and feeder reports weekly to determine the risks of fire from live fire training and other weather conditions to try to prevent any uncontrolled fires. When they conduct their controlled burning they do many tests to make sure the smoke that could affect the public is dissipated as quickly as possible also. Much work goes into keeping the wildlife and the public from harm.
